Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2022-0109-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2022-0109-F requested materials related to a 2002 assessment based on interviews with Guantanamo detainees by Emile Nakhleh.

This FOIA primarily contains questions from reporter Tim Golden of the New York Times for a report on the development of the administration's policy for military detention and prosecution of foreign terrorist suspects, which were then forwarded, with a reply that the White House would not offer further comment.

Please note that a portion of classified records related to this request has not yet been processed. Additional records will be provided as they become available.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2022-0109-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House’s electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
