*The restoration of the 1820s-era Isaiah Davenport House Museum has been cited as the initial project that spurred Savannah's preservation ethic, saving the 1733 city plan and hundreds of structures now encompassed in the National Landmark District. In 2000, after successful private fund-raising efforts, a three-year, three-phase restoration project of the Davenport House began. The museum is now operationally self-funded through innovative revenues sources, including the annual Savannah Garden Exposition. Tourism today produces \$1 billion annually in the city.*



The Honorable President George H. W. Bush:

My name is Peng Kia-Heng from China. The year of 2005 is the 60th anniversary of the World War II. On this memorable occasion, please allow me, a former fight pilot of Flying Tigers of 14th Air Force, to show my deepest respect to you for your gallantry in the World War II and your friendship with my beloved country. My heart-felt gratitude also goes to the people of your great nation, the United States of American, who had made extraordinary sacrifices in supporting the Chinese people in the victory against Japanese invasion.

From 1944 to 1945, under the command of General Chennault, I was a pilot of P40 and P51 flying 64 combat missions during Anti-Japanese War. On July 24, 1945 the Air Medal was rewarded to me and on August 3, 1945, I received the Distinguished Flying Cross, and two Yuan Hai medals awarded by the Republic of China. It is my greatest pride that I was given the honor to fight abreast with my fellow American comrades against the Japanese invaders.

Unfortunately, my cherished medals were no place to be found during the time of political upheavals in China during 1960's. Not until 1991, with the help of then senator Honorable Phil Gramm, US Air Force reissued the medals to me.

For the past 60 years, I had kept the history of being a Flying Tiger pilot to myself and my family until the media came to me in July, 2005. After my awards of Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal were made known to the public, the China National Museum expressed the wish to put them on display. I feel these medals are more than my awards and personal possession. They represent the ultimate sacrifices made by my Chinese and American fellow pilots.

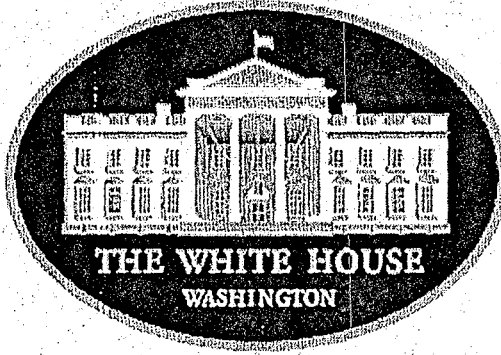
Today, these medal are displayed in the China National Museum at Tian An Men Square. It will be my privilege that some day, when you come to visit China, I could personally accompany you there to appreciate the magnificent glory of the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal, as they stand to witness the enduring friendship between our two great nations.

On February 4, 2004 I sent a formal letter to you about the death of my son 2LT Seth J. Dvorin US Army, ADA 10th Mountain Division.

At the time I wrote my letter, I was broken hearted and mourning the loss of a son that was dear to me. Just how dear he was to me, you will never be able to comprehend.

I told you at that time, that you had made the world a worse place to live. I still stand by my words today, and I must add that you have also made the United States of America an expensive country to live in. I am also disappointed that the Secretary of Defense never had the time to send one of his autopen signed letters to me expressing his condolences. 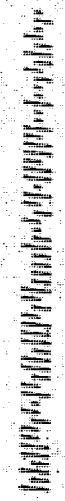

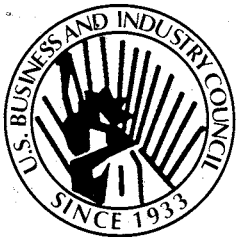

Dear Mr. President:

We the undersigned represent companies and industries that have made an outsized contribution to America's national security and prosperity. We are a critical part of America's domestic manufacturing base. Our enterprises support a large segment of the broad middle class, one of America's singular economic and political achievements. Today our companies in particular and the nation's middle class in general are under constant attack from predatory foreign trade practices.

Our companies and industries still make most of their products in the United States, ensuring that our revenues flow to American working families in the form of wages, to American productive facilities and R&D in the form of reinvestment in our businesses, and to our local, state and national communities in the form of the taxes needed to fund vital public services and our country's security.

All of us are economically and socially critical to our communities. All of us are strong believers in free enterprise. We are job creators. We are productivity drivers. We are technology pioneers. But now, our very existence and ability to create these benefits is being threatened by decades of trade policies that ignore reality and in fact seem designed to close us down.

As a result, we are banding together to urge you respectfully to withhold the Central America Free Trade Agreement (CAFTA) from Congressional consideration as the first step in creating a wholly new U.S. trade policy – one that promotes, not decimates, domestic manufacturing and the middle class along with it.

Although you promise that CAFTA will open big new foreign markets for U.S.-made goods, the opposite is clearly true. The results of the outsourcing deals that have dominated U.S. trade policy over the last fifteen years are in: gargantuan trade deficits, shuttered factories, and formerly middle class American sliding down the job and wage scales. CAFTA is simply the latest in this series of outsourcing deals that are gutting our domestic manufacturing base.

The six other CAFTA signatories are manifestly too small, too poor, and often too indebted to become significant consumer markets for U.S. exports. Their only attraction is to multinational corporations, which see them as low-cost bases for supplying the U.S. market, and as levers to force companies and industries like ours to compete on price rather than on quality and innovation. This is a no-win proposition for domestic manufacturing and for the nation as a whole.

As a result, CAFTA's passage will surely increase net U.S. imports, boost the already dangerously high trade deficit, further weaken the dollar, force the continued fire sale of American assets, and reduce domestic manufacturing output, employment, and technological innovation.

New trade agreements could strengthen domestic manufacturing, but only as part of a thoroughgoing overhaul of U.S. trade policy aimed at promoting domestic production and living standards. Absent new approaches for dealing with challenges such as China's many predatory trade practices, the widespread foreign subsidization of manufacturing, and a deeply flawed set of world trade rules, CAFTA's passage will simply further open America's market to imports without producing comparable export opportunities.


Mr. President, we are life-long entrepreneurs. Far from fearing competition and imports, we have survived outsourcing trade policies so far by out-thinking and out-managing our global competition.

But the cumulative effects of the various CAFTA-like outsourcing deals and the ongoing failure to combat Chinese and other foreign predation are destroying our margins, drying up new investment, and threatening our companies' very futures.

We can assure you that without dramatic policy changes, many of us will soon be forced to close down. That means our companies will no longer be engines of economic growth or pillars of community stability. Our employees will go from taxpayers to consumers of government revenues – in unemployment insurance, retraining, food stamps, Medicaid, and other forms of government assistance. Pressures to enlarge the welfare state, with the concomitant redistribution of our society's wealth, will grow significantly stronger

To remain a true global economic and military superpower, and a prosperous, stable society, the United States urgently needs entirely new trade policies that support domestic manufacturing and its resultant stable communities. Withdrawing CAFTA today is the place to start.

## Bush fans gather for president's stop in small Virginia community

WEST POINT, Va. (AP) -- Ninety-three-year-old Polly Gifford sat in a front row seat just steps from the podium where President Bush would speak, holding a photograph that she knew he could appreciate.

The photo showed Gifford sky diving last September on her birthday.

A White House official called Gifford last week and specially invited her to Monday's presidential event to promote Bush's energy bill for two reasons.

"I'm a die-hard Republican and I'm a skydiver," said Gifford, whose wheelchair had a front-row space reserved for it.

"If the former President Bush could do it (sky dive) on his 80th birthday, I figured I could do it at 93," she said.

As he shook hands after the speech, Bush spotted the white-haired woman and accepted the photo. She asked if he would pose for a photo with her, and Bush took her small digital camera, handed it to an aide and posed with his arm around her shoulder.

It was Gifford's first presidential hug, and minutes afterward, a wide smile still creased her face

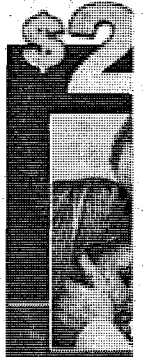

and her eyes still gleamed like new dimes.

She was right at home in the invitation-only crowd of 450 people, almost all of them Republican activists. They sat outside Virginia Biodiesel, a small steel building set next to a marshy area.

"You had to get a ticket through a local Republican politician or officeholder," said Floyd Gibbs, a Republican Party volunteer from Hampton.

"I don't think you'll see any protesters out here today," he said with a wry grin.

Del. Harvey Morgan, R-Gloucester, said he was pleased that Bush chose a site near his district. Last year, Morgan introduced legislation that would have required a 2 percent biodiesel mixture in diesel sold in Virginia. The bill was withdrawn, however, in favor of a study on the effectiveness of biodiesel.

"Our dependancy on foreign oil is like a tax on the American dream, and that tax is going up every year," Bush said.

Bush selected the out-of-the-way refinery at the edge of Chesapeake Bay country to prod the Senate to take up the energy bill the House approved last month.

The thrust of the bill is to make the United States less dependent on imported oil, and a key point of the legislation is to produce more fuel from renewable, biological sources such as ethanol, made from corn, and the homegrown diesel fuel Virginia Biodiesel Refinery turns out.

It requires petroleum refiners to use 5 billion gallons of corn-based ethanol by 2012, a 20 percent increase over what the industry is expected to produce this year.

The refinery, a small business about 35 miles east of Richmond, produces about 1.5 million gallons of biodiesel fuel per year from virgin soybean oil.

More contentious provisions of the bill call for oil drilling in Alaska's pristine Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and \$8 billion in tax breaks for oil, gas, coal, nuclear and electric utilities.

The White House orchestrated the brief trip solely to promote the president's energy policy and planned no appearances with or fund-raising events for Republicans seeking statewide office in elections this November.

Presidential visits across the Potomac River to such Virginia venues as Arlington, the Pentagon and even the world's largest U.S. Navy base in Norfolk are not unusual.

Bush's visit to rural West Point, a quaint, out-of-the-way rural town of bed-and-breakfast inns along major Chesapeake Bay tributaries, left lifetime residents gawking like tourists.

Bush also picked an area where he is popular. Voters in the region supported his re-election by a 2-to-1 margin last fall.



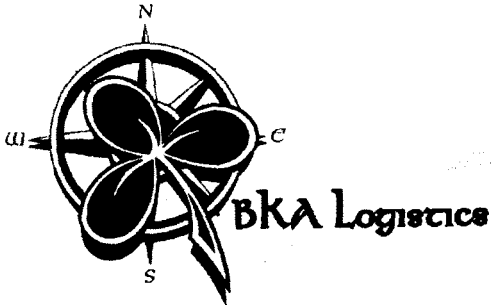

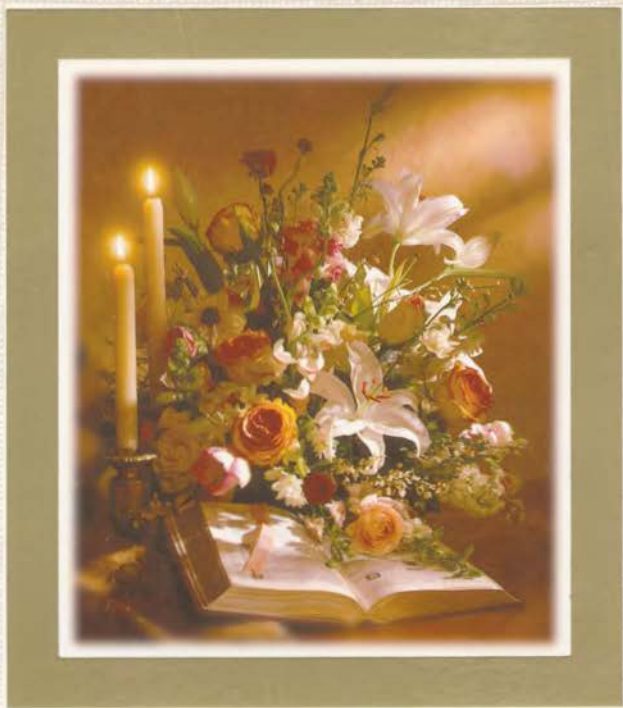
