#### Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2018-0187-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2018-0187-F requested materials related to the energy policy plan proposed by businessman T. Boone Pickens, known as the Pickens Plan.

This FOIA primarily contains memos comparing energy proposals by T. Boone Pickens and former Vice President Al Gore, question and answer drafts for events on energy and fuel, emails containing analysis of the Pickens Plan, emails discussing the Administration's response to the Pickens Plan, reports tracking incoming emails from the public on current issues, messages from the public supporting the Pickens Plan, emails containing testimony submitted to the Select Committee on Energy Independence and Global Warming, energy briefings, and articles on the Pickens Plan.

## **System of Arrangement**

The materials in FOIA 2018-0187-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.

The following is a list of electronic search results lists (SRLs) processed in response to FOIA 2018-0187-F:

### ***George W. Bush Electronic Records***

CEA contains 11 assets, all of which are released in full.

Exchange contains 262 assets, of which 190 are released in full, 6 are withheld in part, and 66 are withheld in full.

WHO contains 11 assets, all of which 11 are released in full.
