## Chief of Staff's Office Talking Points

- Today Josh Bolten recommended and President Bush has selected Joel Kaplan to serve as Deputy Chief of Staff for Policy.
- Joel will be responsible for the policy development process in the White House. He will work closely with the policy councils and cabinet agencies to provide the President with the best possible advice on all matters of policy.
- Joel's experience over the last five years makes him uniquely qualified for the job. During the first three years in the White House, Joel served as Special Assistant to the President in the Office of the Chief of Staff – under the direct supervision of Josh Bolten -- where he assisted in the coordination, development, and implementation of Administration policy. In this role, Mr. Kaplan focused on a wide range of issues including international economic affairs, homeland security, energy, and transportation.
- As Deputy Director of OMB, Joel has been intimately involved in all aspects of the President's agenda, and has worked with both the Congress and the cabinet to getting it enacted.

### Q and A:

Q. I thought Karl Rove was in charge of policy for the Chief of Staff's office? Has Karl's role changed, and will he remain Deputy Chief of Staff?

A. Each Chief of Staff will organize the office in the way that supports them best. Joel has worked with Josh closely for six years. Karl will continue to serve as Deputy Chief of Staff and Senior Advisor. With Joel coming in to manage the daily policy process, Karl will have more time to focus on important strategic planning during a critical time in the presidency.

As he has been from the beginning of the administration, Karl will be a crucial voice and trusted advisor on policy matters.

Q. So was the responsibility stripped from Karl?

A. Josh thought it was important to have one person focused solely on daily management of the policy process. Karl performed well carrying an incredibly large load. This will free Karl up to focus on the big, strategic decisions required during an important year.

Q. Isn't this an acknowledgment that the White House policy process has been off its game...failure to overhaul Social Security, uncoordinated response to Katrina...Dubai Ports deal?

A. Each Chief of Staff will organize the office in the way that supports them best. Joel has worked with Josh closely for six years. Joel knows how Josh wants the policy process to run, because he helped Josh do that during the first three years.

Q. Will Joe Hagin and Mike Gerson's role change in the Chief of Staff's Office, or just Karl's?

A. In the chief of staff's office, Joel will be in charge of management of the policy process, so to the extent Mike and Joe performed those functions, it will now rest with Joel. However they will continue to provide key advice on many issues.
