THE PRESIDENT HAS SEEN

I. PURPOSE

To ask Chairman Larry Combest (R-TX) to support H.R. 3005, the Trade Promotion Authority Act of 2001 and to urge his committee members to do so as well.

II. BACKGROUND

Chairman Combest withdrew his name as a co-sponsor of the Trade Promotion Authority bill in June, 2001. This was in reaction to the Department of Agriculture's announcement that we had classified \$10.4 billion as domestic support payments (also known as "amber box" payments) to satisfy WTO obligations.

As you know, the situation deteriorated when we strongly opposed the Farm Bill in the House. We have fundamental differences on policy including our opposition to counter cyclical payments.

Throughout the summer and early fall, Chairman Combest has repeatedly expressed his concern over voting for Trade Promotion Authority (TPA). He was worried about the direction of our agriculture policy as well as our willingness to fight for agriculture at the negotiating table.

We have spent considerable time with him over the last six weeks, however, and he is pleased with the progress we are making.
