I. PURPOSE

To emphasize your commitment to education, especially minority achievement and reading, and call on Congress to pass the Education Reform bill.

II. BACKGROUND

The three goals of Reading Week are (1) to emphasize your commitment to education and the importance of reading; (2) to explain the current research on teaching reading and the importance of research-based teacher training in reading instruction; and (3) to motivate Congress not to delay needed education reforms.

A. About Your Reading Initiative

You have three reading initiatives in the House and the Senate ESEA bills currently in conference. Reading First would provide \$900 million a year to help States and local districts implement comprehensive reading instruction in kindergarten through the third grade that is grounded in scientifically-based reading research. Early Reading First would provide \$75 million to enhance pre-reading skills for children in model Head Start and other preschool programs. You have also proposed that States administer reading assessments to all students in grades 3-8, which is also in the education bill.

B. Emma E. Booker Elementary School

Emma E. Booker Elementary School is a high-poverty, minority school with 90 percent of its students receiving free and/or reduced lunch. Eighty percent of the students are African American. The school's motto is "High Expectations for All," and, in that spirit, the school's administration is focused on achieving success for all students by using good reading strategies. The school is participating in the Corner School Development Program, which is affiliated with Yale University and is designed to create a school climate in which parents, children, staff, and the community work together to respond to

the students' academic and social needs. Collaboration, consensus, and a no-fault philosophy help give the school a unique learning environment. They also have a daily after school tutorial program for reading, writing, and math.

Emma E. Booker Elementary School is named for the African-American educator who started the first permanent school for blacks in the Sarasota area. It has a mandatory uniform policy and is one of only 300 schools nationwide implementing the Corner School Development Program. This year, its State school accountability grade moved from a "D" to a "C," partially because of improvement in its reading scores: the number of students scoring Level 2 and above (out of five levels) increased from 55% in 2000 to 63% in 2001; students scoring Level 3 and above increased from 36% in 2000 to 37% in 2001. Similar gains were made in mathematics and writing. They use SRA for reading, as well as direct instruction.

Thaddeus Lott, who is from Houston and pioneered the SRA instruction model form of instruction, visited the Emma E. Booker Elementary School in April to help them implement their research-based program.

- The school's web site contains "Reading Tips" for parents, including a suggestion to spend at least 20 minutes every day reading at home.
- Every morning, students recite the Pledge of Allegiance and the Emma E. Booker Affirmation:
 "I believe knowledge is great power. I want to be well educated. I will learn the basic skills and beyond. I will complete all assignments. I will strive for punctuality and good attendance. I believe I can do

anything if I work hard. I pledge this to my school, my family, and myself. Today's students, tomorrow's leaders!"

Suggested Lines

- We face a national crisis in education, and it demands immediate attention.
- Many people argue that we need to spend more money on education – and we provide record levels of funding for elementary and secondary education. But as this chart shows, we must combine resources with reform if we expect our children to learn.
- The stakes are high. Thirty-seven percent of fourth-graders cannot read at the basic level. That's almost 1.4 million children each year who can't read and understand a basic children's book. If we don't act this year, we'll lose another 1.4 million. If we don't act, we're basically telling children we don't care if you fail. But I do care. And this must stop.
- These children are silently shuffling through the system, and if they don't get help, they won't catch up. Studies show that 74 percent of students who aren't reading by the third grade and don't get research-based reading help will continue to have reading problems later in life. That's a terrible fate to offer a child.
- It will be a national scandal if this bill is delayed by partisan politics. Every child in America who cannot read will be on the conscience of those who stand in the way of reform.
