This FOIA contains video footage from tapes WHTV 600 09/12/2001 President Tours Damage of the Pentagon and WHTV 603 09/10/2001 Photo Op Tape #1 for 09/10/2001 - 09/16/2001. Footage from tape WHTV 603 includes a walk through the Rose Garden and Colonnade and

lunch at the White House with Australian Prime Minister John Howard on September 10th, President George W. Bush's arrival to the White House on Marine One on September 11th, a photo op and remarks to the press during a cabinet meeting on September 12th, a photo op of a joint congressional leadership meeting at the White House on September 12th, and a phone call by President Bush to New York Governor George Pataki and New York Mayor Rudolph Giuliani and a statement to the press in the Oval Office on September 13th. Footage from tape WHTV 600 includes President George W. Bush and Secretary of State Donald Rumsfeld greeting rescue workers and surveying damage at the Pentagon and the President, Condoleezza Rice, Andy Card and Karen Hughes returning to the White House on September 12, 2001.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2021-0032-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Staff Member Office Files.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

White House Communications Agency records are processed at the folder/videotape level. While this method maintains folder/videotape integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of videotapes that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
