Introduction

This guide includes the principle files at the George W. Bush Presidential Library that contain material relating to Afghanistan that have been processed and are available for research. It is not definitive, however, and researchers should consult with the Library's archivists about other potentially useful files.

This guide identifies materials that have been opened for research through systematic processing or under a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. Check the <u>George W. Bush Presidential Library website</u>, as it is constantly updated with new <u>finding aids</u> and <u>digitized content</u>. If records are available digitally, a link has been provided.
